Instruction for Completing Ticket Application Form (Hong Kong Region)

From 1 April 2015 to 15 April 2015

1. All Hong Kong residents who would like to purchase Rio 2016 Olympic tickets should complete this Ticket Application Form. Please read through this Instruction together with Terms and Conditions for Ticket Sales. Submission of ticket reservations shall indicate customers acknowledge and agree to all these terms and conditions of sales.
2. No cancellation for all Ticket Reservations submitted. However, ticket allocation is made by ROCOG and ticket reservation made does not imply successful purchase of tickets.
3. Ticket Reservation and Sales is only open to Hong Kong identity cardholders aged 18 or above.
4. CTS will collect personal information in the process of ticket reservation and sales. CTS may forward your personal information collected to ROCOG or SF&OC for security reason.
5. Please fill in the Form in black or blue ink and please write legibly. CTS will not be held responsibility of unsuccessful ticket reservation due to illegibility.
6. English and Chinese name on the Ticket Reservation Form should be identical to your HKID card.
7. Please provide at least one contact telephone number, fixed or mobile. We suggest you provide your mobile number.
8. Correspondence address must be a valid Hong Kong address.
9. Each applicant can only submit one application form either online or via a paper copy. On each application form, applicant may select up to 5 different sessions of tickets, including ceremony sessions. No more than 2 ceremony tickets in total can be purchased per person. For each of the sports session, each person can purchase up to a maximum of 4 tickets. The computer system will automatically adjust the quantity of tickets base on the above ceiling if the input number is higher than the maximum allowed.
10. If the price category of the tickets requested is not available, we will offer tickets of the same session but at a lower price category, until no tickets are available. If tickets at lower price categories cannot be offered, the ticket reservation will be considered failed. This arrangement will apply to all tickets requested for the same session. If you do not prefer to purchase at lower price categories than your request, please indicate by marking an "X" on the Form. Leaving the check box empty means you agree to the above arrangement.
11. If the session date/time/sport/session codes do not tally, CTS will take session codes as the final request to proceed. If the price category and unit price do not tally, CTS will take price category as the final request to proceed.
12. If you will not purchase tickets for any other sessions if you are not allotted tickets for any particular sessions, please put a "" under the "Pre-requisite" check box. For example, if you apply for 4 sessions, one of which is Opening Ceremony and you will give up all other 3 sessions if you are not allotted Opening Ceremony ticket, please put a "" under the "Pre-requisite" check box. You can tick more than one check box.
13. If the total number of ticket requests exceed the total ticket allotment for Hong Kong, all applications will be entered in a lucky draw.
14. Please indicate whether you want to receive the Notification Letter by e-mail, fax or mail.
15. Ticket prices are set by ROCOG in Brazilian Real (BRL), CTS will only accept HKD for ticket purchase.
16. A handling fee is approved by ROCOG to be collected by CTS. Ticket prices and handling fees are listed out separately. Please look up our website: www.ctshk.com for ticket prices and handling fees of all sessions.
17. If you would like to purchase wheel-chair tickets, you must fill in the Box "No. of wheel-chair seat". The number of wheel-chair spaces shall be part of the total ticket quantity of that session. A companion seat is included in the cost of a ticket for a wheelchair space. Wheel-chair arrangement is subject to confirmation of ROCOG. If total amount of wheel-chair tickets and companion tickets is more than the allotment for Hong Kong, wheel-chair seats will be allocated via a computerized ballot.
18. All event dates, time, sessions and venues are subject to final confirmation by ROCOG.
19. Please keep all the Notification Letter, Payment Receipt, Ticket Exchange Coupon safe and sound in exchange for the final Olympic tickets in due course.
20. All ticket purchasers agree that all tickets bought may not be re-sold or used to promote any person, entity, product or service. Ticket purchasers agree to hold responsibility for violation of the above.
21. If the Games are cancelled or if ROCOG ceases to be responsible for organizing the Games, ticket purchasers agree not to bring any claim or take any action for indemnity, damages or compensation against ROCOG, IOC, SF&OC and CTS.
22. Any unlisted matter will follow the rules and regulations of ROCOG.
23. China Travel Service (Hong Kong) Limited has the right to make the final decision in the event of any dispute.
24. In case of discrepancy, English version will be used.
