**Re: 2025-26 Div. I Age Group Short Course Swimming Competition (Part 3)**

Due to the unavailability of pool operation, please note that the warm up and start time of the afternoon session on Day 1 – 24<sup>th</sup> January 2026 will be revised as 2 pm and 3 pm respectively.

To ease the potential safety problem and have better crowd control supervision, only those who can present the authorized e-tickets are allowed to enter Victoria Park Swimming Pool. All participants are required to present the authorized e-tickets in electronic devices to the responsible officials at the entrance. The authorized e-ticket is attached.

The Association has the responsibilities to remind all the clubs and swimmers to be abided by the rules and regulations of the public swimming pools and the Fire Services Ordinance. The following practices will be implemented to maintain clear passageways and escape routes:

**East Wing Spectator Area**

1. Swimmers must not place any items to obstruct the escape routes and the access to the Fireman's Lift, except the designated disabled area for wheelchairs (priority will be given to individuals with disabilities).
2. No belongings could be placed to obstruct at the wheelchair ramp.
3. A clear passage of 1.5 meters must be maintained.

**West Wing Spectator Area**

1. Personal belongings such as yoga mat are allowed to place at the designated area in between the pillars only (near to the window side).
2. A clear passage of 1.5 meters must be maintained.
3. Conference room at the 1/F will be opened as resting area for all swimmers only. The room must not be locked. No eating or drinking except water is allowed to keep it clean and tidy. Swimmers please be reminded to use the Swimmers Resting Area in a civilized manner.

Any unattended items on the passageway will be removed. The Association is not responsible for any property loss during the competition. Swimmers should take care of all your personal belongings.

Those swimmers who are found not complying with the rules and regulations might be ticketed by the concerned department. If our association suffers any reputational damage from being ticketed, the affiliated clubs of the concerned swimmers will be held accountable.



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Warning letter will be issued to those swimmers who are found not complying with the rules and regulations, subject to penalty (such as suspension) as decided by HKGSA.

Coaches are allowed to use two types of walkie-talkies which are exempted from holding a license only in the swimming pool. For details, please refer to the attached Competition Arrangement.
